### Brief Annual Review 2007

The Board of Trustees together with the CPs have been working very hard to put in place several business initiatives to achieve "**Self-Sufficiency 2010**". During Board meetings, all directors are constantly urged to rally a strong local support base to fulfil all initiatives. A Youth Wing will soon be formed to encourage younger members to play an active role in the ministry of the Trust.

#### SPV Operations

We are glad that the income from fee collection has increased by 45%. This has helped to pay most expenses. Our teachers have also enjoyed a little better salary. The next target is to improve the teaching resources and facilities. At the moment, everyone is excited for the major move to the new school premise when school term starts in June 2008.

#### New SPV School Building

General foundation works at ground level has been completed. The next stage is to construct the ceiling and the M&E works. A brick making plant is now set up to supply all bricks needed to complete the new building. We are seeking interest-free loans urgently.

#### Village Ministry

We could only complete one worship shed. We hope to complete 2 more by mid 2008. The Trust received 7 pieces of land donated by sponsored villages in June 2006 to build worship sheds for chapel service and community activities.

#### Cattle Farming

We bought 6 cows in February 07 and they have produced 3 healthy calves. Milk is now harvested for sale. We pray this venture will breakeven by end 2009.
